GRADUATION EXERCISES

Background

The Division's mission is to inspire all students to explore, develop and celebrate their unique gifts and abilities. The Division expects that a student will complete a program of studies and fulfill a set of graduation criteria as defined by Alberta Education in order to graduate and complete their educational career in the Division.

Procedures

- 1. Each school may hold either a fall graduation, spring ceremony or both.
- 2. Where a Division school has organized a spring commencement ceremony, the student must be registered in a program to satisfy all the requirements necessary to meet the Alberta Diploma, Alberta Certificate of Achievement, or Individual Program Plan for graduation by the end of the school year.
- 3. For high school graduations, the Superintendent and Board Chair will be invited to bring greetings in the ceremony.
- 4. For high school graduations the local Mayor will be invited to briefly bring greetings in the ceremony.
- 5. For high school graduations an Elder or Knowledge Keeper and member of the Métis Government will be invited to bring greetings in the ceremony.
